

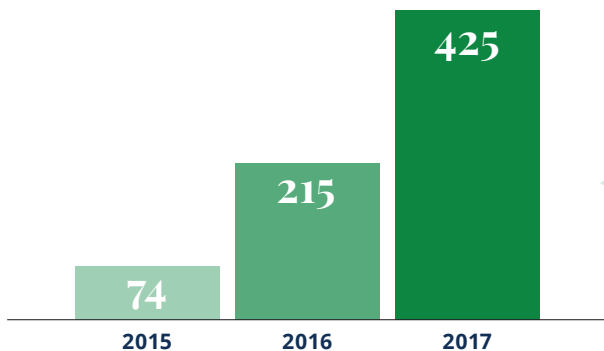
# More Choices for Students at a Better Price

Both two-year and four-year colleges and universities are using Inclusive Access to save students money and make getting course materials more convenient.



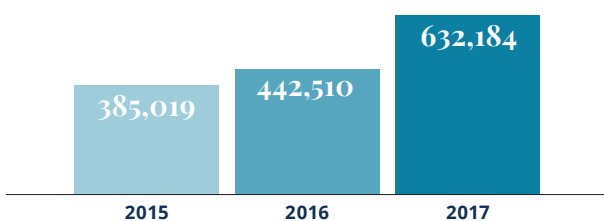

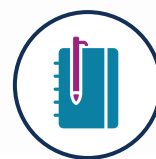

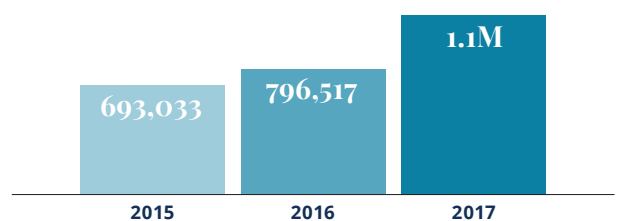


### Course Enrollments
